Purpose

- Australian Government Research Training Program (RTP) Stipend Schodaesawpsrded to applicants of exceptional research potential undertaking a Higher Degree by Research (RTIDR) tipend Scholarshipare provided to assist with general living costs through the provision of a stipend.
- 1.2 RTP Stipend Scholarships

Stipend Rate

- 1.9 The annual rate of the RTP Stipend Scholars III pe \$35,000 per annum for a candidate enrolled full-time (pro-rata for parttime, see 1.18) The level of the stipend will be reduced during the period of the award.
- 1.10 The stipend rate will be detailed in the scholarship offer letter.

Duration

- 1.11 The duration of a fullime RTP Stipend Scholars is pthree and a halfyears for a candidate undertaking a Doctor of Philosophy course.
- The duration of an RTP Stipend Scholars/illpbe reduced by any period of study undertaken towards a Higher Degree by Researcoburseprior to the commencement of the RTP Stipend Schola(shopprior enrolment in a PhD course at University of Canbersau, casessful research degree transfer from other institution to University of Canberray, an upgrade/transfer into a Ph) Dor any period the candidate was in receipt of anRTP Stipend Scholarshop institution or elsewhere.
- 1.13 Some periods of Universityapproved leave as prescribed in these conditions will extend the end date of the RTP Stipend Scholarsbijothe number of days approved (see Paid Leave Entitlements and Unpaid Leave)
- Scholarship recipients are expected to notify Graduate Resediathy changes to their candidature at least four weeks prior to avoid overpayment of the stipend. Scholarship recipients will be required to repay any stipend payments to which they were not entitled is should be considered when a scholarship recipient makes a change to their candidature that retroactively affects their scholarship eligibility.

Part-time Study

- 1.15 The University may approve a pairne stipend for a domestic recipient only if the recipient has exceptional circumstances.
- 1.16 For the purpose of partime study, the University must be satisfied that the exceptional circumstances relate to significant cær commitments or health condition, including:
 - a. being the primary carer of a prechoolagedchild;
 - b. being the primary carer of a schooled child and a sole parent with limited access to outside support;
 - c. being the primary carer for an invalid or disabled spouse, child or parent;

- 1.18 Stipends for partime stipend scholarships are not tax exempt.
- 1.19 If a scholarship recipient is approved to undertake their HDR coursatipment, their partitime scholarship stipend will be 50 per cent of the **furthe** stipend rate.
- 1.20 A scholarship recipient approved to study ptante may revert to fulltime study with the permission of the University. Information on transferring from fullne to part-time and vice versa is detailed in the Higher Degree by Research Policy (ies)

Paid Leave Entitlements

- 1.21 The duration of the RTP Stipend Scholarshipaybe extended by periods of approved leave, as specified below.
- 1.22 All leave entitlements will be forfeited once the scholarship has ended.
- 1.23 For the purpose of calculating leave entitlements, one working daynsidered to be necelendar day.

Sick Leave

- 1.24 The recipient is entitled to working daysaid sick leave per scholarshjear, as per the scholarship duration detailed on the scholarship offer letterny paid sick leave not consumed in a scholarship year may be accrued over the duration the scholarship award
- All sick leave requires the submission of an Application for Leave from Candidatur to Formulate Research The application for leave must have the Primary Supervisor's endorsement and the approval of the Faculty Associate Dean Resear For sick leavef less than 10 consecutive working days the end date of the scholarship will not be extended except in circumstance where the recipient as a relevant Reasonable Adjustment Plan in place.
- 1.26 Recipients may also receive additional paid sick leave of up to 60 working days during the scholarship for periods of medically substantiated illness lasting longer than 10 conse**w** diverged days.
- Applications for additional sick leave must be submitted via the Application for Leave from Candidature Formto Graduate Research he application for leavenust have the Primary Supervisor's endorsement and the approval of the Faculty sociate Dean Research he end date of the scholarship will tend for periods of approved additional sick leave of 10 or more on secutive working days.
- 1.28 Sick leave entitlements may be used to cover recipients with family responsibilities, caring for sick children or relatives
- 1.29 All sick leave applications sust be submitted within 30 calendardays of the end date on the ave period. The

- 1.31 RTP Stipend Scholarshippipients are entitled to 20 working days paid recreation leave per scholarship year. Any paid recreation leave not consumed in a scholarship year may be accrued over the duration of the scholarship award.
- 1.32 Recreation leave is managed within the recipient's host Faculty and doesquote the submission of form. The end date of the scholarship will not extended for periods of recreation leave.

ParentalLeave

- 1.33 Scholarship recipients who have completed 12 monthlstime (365 days) of their award are entitled to a maximum of 60 working days papidrentalleavefor the birth or adoption of a childluring the tenure of their award.
- 1.34 Scholarship recipients who have an enrolment status of pare at the time of applying for parental leave must have completed the uivalent of 12 monthsfull-time (730calendardays parttime) of their awardto be entitled to a maximum of 60 working days paid maternity le(41/26) working days part time).
- 1.35 Scholarship recipients when who partners are giving birth, and who have completed 12 months fulfne (or part-time equivalent) of their awar, are entitled to a period of 10 working days paid entalleave at the time of the birth Parentalleave maybe taken one week before the birth dup to five weeks after the birth of the child.
- 1.36 A medical certificats tating the anticipated date of birth must be submitted to Graduate Research least six weeks before leave is planned.

- 1.42 Recipients may apply for a temporary suspension of their scholarship for a period totalling up to 12 monthsduring the total period of the awardn exceptional circumstances only (circumstances beyond the recipient's control), recipients may apply for suspensions beyond 12 months.
- 1.43 If intermission from studger a suspension of the cholarship are approved, threcipient's scholarship end date will be adjusted and increased by the number of letayes taken.
- 1.44 All applications for unpaid leaveust be submitted via the Application for Leave from Candidature Form to Graduate Research application for leave must have the Primary Supervisor's endorsement and the approval of the Faculth Dean Research
- 1.45 Recipients must notify Graduate Researcheast fourweeks prior to resuming study following a period of approved intermission from study.
- 1.46 Recipients who suspend their studies without notifying Graduate Reseal to repay any scholarship stipend payments to which they were not entitled.
